Enhanced Data Sharing Capabilities of PrimeSuite Enables Physicians to Make the Most Informed Decisions When Time is of the Essence

With *PrimeSuite* and the APS, the physician will have access to the patient's health history when he/she needs it most.

The APS is based on the American College of Obstetricians and Gynecologist (ACOG) antepartum record. Through the APS, the most crucial information, including ongoing diagnoses, estimated due dates, previous pregnancy outcomes and other important benchmarks are recorded. During the labor and delivery period, the physician must review this information in order to administer the proper treatment and delivery of the baby. When APS data is contained in an EHR solution like *PrimeSuite*, it is readily available should the labor begin early or the physician needs to make quick decisions beneficial to the welfare of the mother and child.
